Hello and welcome to the Kiwi room! This room focuses on the children's independence, social skills, vocabulary and learning through play. One of our main goals in this class is to encourage the children to try new textures, sensory experiences and to explore any challenges that they might face.

- ❖ Arrival: To ensure that your child's day starts off on the right foot, please have your child arrive by circle-time, at 9:30am. Circle time is the perfect opportunity for the children to sing and dance with instruments, read their favorite stories, learn their ABC's and numbers, learn new vocabulary, learn to communicate with others, and most important, explore.
- ❖ Potty: Every Kiwi learns to sit on the potty and begins to transition from diapers to underwear.
- Cups: We encourage the children to drink from regular cups rather than sippy cups.
